Cascade Clamp - Cascade Manufacturing Company was established in Portland, Oregon in the year 1943. They started out as a small machine shop initially employing 4 people. Product sales for their first year of operation totaled \$60,000. The very first recorded sales revenues involved the assembly and machining of stainless steel valves, pipe fittings and different components. Throughout 5 years of operation, the business had expanded to 40 staff and their annual sales volume had increased to \$330,000. These days, Cascade is amongst the top global makers within the material handling trade.

Design and manufacturing of the company's initial hydraulic cylinder allowed this young company to aggressively pursue better business possibilities. All through the last sixty years, the business of material handling has developed into a very sophisticated area with Cascade proudly playing a part in its progress. Cascade presently continues to develop as the leader supplier of lift truck attachments and various associated items. The business feels certain in their skill so as to continue to lead the way within the business by understanding customer's needs in the future and remaining competitive in the world market.

In the nineteen fifties, Cascade started designing, fabricating and advertising hydraulic accessories. Construction was finished in 1956 on a brand new office to be able to house all plant and office operations in Portland, Oregon at the company's current center of operations. After fifteen years of business, total employees reached one hundred eighty employees and sales had reached practically two million three hundred thousand dollars.

A second production plant was built in the year 1959 in Springfield, Everett. nineteen sixty marked Cascade's preliminary transfer into the international world of the material handling industry while the company established interest in England, Australia, and the Netherlands.

In the year 1964, the business changed its name to the Cascade Corporation. After that in the year 1965, the business went public with an initial offering of 200,000 shares of common stock. Since then the company has expanded its manufacturing amenities within the continental USA to the locations Warner Robins Georgia to go along with its already present plants in Portland, Oregon and Springfield, Everett. Cascade products are manufactured internationally because of numerous subsidiary operations. In 1994, a new facility was accomplished in Almere, the Netherlands which is Cascade's European headquarters. This facility is built to be the ultimate customer service centre.

Continuing to develop, Cascade expanded their product offering further in 1996 and 1997 with the remarkable acquisition of five corporations, including the global leader in blades, the Kenhar Corporation.
